THE MESSAGE OF ISAIAH

ISAIAH 1-39 – A KING TO LEAD GOD'S NEW COMMUNITY

Isaiah 11:10 (NIV - Anglicised)

¹⁰ In that day the Root of Jesse will stand as a banner for the peoples; the nations will rally to him, and his place of rest will be glorious.

ISAIAH 40-55 – A SUFFERING SERVANT TO DIE FOR THE SINS OF GOD'S NEW COMMUNITY

Isaiah 52:14–15 (NIV - Anglicised)

¹⁴ Just as there were many who were appalled at him—his appearance was so disfigured beyond that of any man and his form marred beyond human likeness—
¹⁵ so will he sprinkle many nations...

ISAIAH 56-66 – A PROCLAIMER TO DECLARE THE GOSPEL TO GOD'S NEW COMMUNITY

Isaiah 61:1, 11

The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to preach good news to the poor.... the Sovereign Lord will make righteousness and praise spring up before all nations.

ROMANS 15:1-13 ACCEPT AND BEAR WITH ONE ANOTHER AS GOD'S NEW COMMUNITY

This is rooted in the whole message of the Bible – vv9- 12.

Romans 15:12 (NIV - Anglicised)

¹² And again, Isaiah says,

"The Root of Jesse will spring up,
one who will arise to rule over the nations;
the Gentiles will hope in him."
