What happens as Jesus dies? Why does Mark cut to the temple? What does that mean for us?

It's striking that Jesus' identity is pronounced for all to hear (read) just as he dies from the lips of the Centurion. Why do you think this is? What does it mean for the significance of the cross?

How does it cost the different people as they respond to Jesus' death? How are they examples for us?

What might you say to a skeptic from these verses if they doubted that this historically happened?
