

Esther 6 - A great reversal

- 1) How many examples of God's providence can you see here in chapters 6 and 7?
 - ➤ How, and in what, has that encouraged you to trust God this week?
- 2) Can you relate to Mordecai seemingly being overlooked (until now) for saving the king's life in chapter 2? How does what happens to Mordecai here (and passages like Matthew 6:1-4 and Colossians 3:22-24) encourage you in that?
- 3) God is clearly at work in bringing about this great reversal, but we also see Esther play her part as she boldly approaches king Xerxes.
 - ➤ How does knowing God is providentially at work in the world give you confidence to be bold in the way you live as a Christian?
 - ➤ Are there ways in which you can pray for each other to be bold in light of this, this week?

- 4) How do these passages help us see (and rejoice in) how this reversal points forward to an even greater reversal? (Philippians 2:5-11, Colossians 2:14-15)
- 5) Whilst there is still unfinished business in the book of Esther (the edict against the Jews of Esther 3:13-14) we're left feeling more confident about the outcome because of what has happened here in chapters 6 and 7.

How are we able to trust God for the future with confidence as a result of the great reversal of the cross? (Romans 8:18 and 31-39 are helpful!)
