

Hebrews 9:15-28: Nothing but the blood

V15-18

What do believers have to look forward to in this passage?

We can't see it in English translations but the original word for covenant and Will are the same. A will requires the death of the relevant person for the benefits of the will to come into effect. The death of Jesus brings his children an inheritance - an eternal inheritance.

This wasn't the only time death and the shedding of blood has brought God's blessing. V18
