



Hebrews 10:19-39 : Keep Going!

As you look through the whole passage, what seems to be going on? What is the writer's main concern? What are the times when we have found it hardest to persevere?

What are the reasons we are given as to why we can draw near to God? How can we draw on these things when we find it hard to draw near to God? Practically- what does drawing near to God look like? How have you found that it helps you to persevere?

What might be ways in which we can spur one another on towards love and good deeds so that we persevere?

What is the concern that the writer has in v.26-31? What impact should it have on us?

What is the writer trying to do in v.32-35? How does looking back on the way we have served in the past help us to persevere?

The writer clearly wants them to look forward- v.23, end of v.25 and v.36-38. What are you most looking forward to in terms of God's promises? How can we keep that central such that it motivates us to keep running?

As you think about this call to persevere, what is the main thing that encourages you from the passage and what is the main thing you might want to do differently?
