



John 4:27-42 - Come and join the harvest!

Jesus transforms lives (v27-30)

- What are the changes we see in the Samaritan woman after her interaction with Jesus?
- What do you think gave the woman the boldness to speak to the people in the way she did?
- As you look back on your Christian life, can you see how trusting in Jesus has transformed you? Was it sudden or more gradual?

Jesus calls us to join him in the harvest (v31-38)

- What does Jesus mean when He says, *“My food is to do the will of Him who sent me”*?
- What point do you think Jesus is making by talking about harvest and ‘sowing’ and ‘reaping’?
- What is the significance of the ‘harvest’ that Jesus talks about here?
- What does this teach us about our role in ‘sowing’ and ‘reaping’?

Jesus is the key to the harvest (v39-42)

- Why do you think the townspeople were so receptive to the woman’s testimony?
- What impact did her story have on the people around her?
- What do these verses teach us about the importance of Jesus’ words in evangelism?
- How does this passage challenge or encourage you in your own testimony and sharing of faith?
