Should we not embrace justice? (v1-4)

- Who is Micah addressing here and what is the charge against them?
- What will happen when they cry out to the Lord and why is that significant?
- Where do we see injustice like this around us now and can you think of ways in which we might be complicit in injustice today?

Having the right motivation (v5-8)

- What is Micah's charge against the prophets in these verses and what does God say will happen to them?
- Are there ways in which we are tempted not to change our message/alter the truth to suit our own ends today?
- How is v8 an encouragement to us?

God's justice points us to his mercy (v9-12)

- What are the corrupt practices of the leaders we see in these verses?
- What is God's response to these sins?
- Read Jeremiah 26:18-19. How does this encourage us *and point us to Christ) in the midst of the judgement warned of here in Micah 3?
