



Micah 7:1-20 - Who is a God like you?

1) V1-7 A God who we can trust, even in the mess

- What is causing Micah's misery in these verses?
- Micah 7:5-6 describes a complete breakdown of trust, even within families. Can you see any parallels today?
- How is Micah (in v7) a great example to us of how to respond to living in a sinful world?

2) V8-13 A God who provides for his people

- What does Micah say is his hope, despite the 'darkness' he is enduring?
- These verses show a day will come when God's enemies will be defeated. What is the promise for God's people? How does this give us hope as it points us forward to the Lord Jesus?

3) V14-20 A God who delights to show mercy

- How is the prayer for God to shepherd his people so different from the way their leaders have led them?
- What is the character of God that is highlighted in v18-20? How has God demonstrated these in Christ?
- What has challenged/encouraged you most in this passage (or in Micah as a whole)?
