



This Sunday at Magdalen Road Church we began a new sermon series on the Upper Room Discourse from John's gospel (chapter 14-17)

This week we just looked at verses 1 to 4 from chapter 14 and considered why it was **better** that Jesus goes to the cross, rather than for him to stay with them.

- Why do you think the disciples are anxious? What command does he give them? Why should they listen?
- Why is it that Jesus is going to the Father? Why is this better? What does he promise?
- We said that Jesus was the way to the Father, the truth about the Father and life from the Father. These are big concepts! How do they begin to shape our understanding of life?
