

John 4:1-26 - Jesus offers us living water

Jesus loves the wrong sort of people

- What do we learn about the woman Jesus meets here that makes her the 'wrong' sort of person for Jesus to be associating with?
- How does Jesus interact with her?
- What does Jesus teach us here about the way we love people who are different from us?

Jesus offers living water...

- What's special about the 'living water' Jesus offers the Samaritan woman?
- What is revealed to us about the woman's need for this water?
- In what ways do we try and satisfy our spiritual thirst in the wrong ways and how can we have the water Jesus offers?

... so that we might worship in Spirit and truth

- Do you think the woman is changing the subject in verse 19 or does she want to know more?
- What do you think Jesus means by worshiping in 'the Spirit and in truth' (see also John 7:38-39) and how is Jesus the key to that?
- How can we worship in 'Spirit and truth' in our lives today?
